Several Prentice Graduates who spent at least 2 years at our school will be speaking.

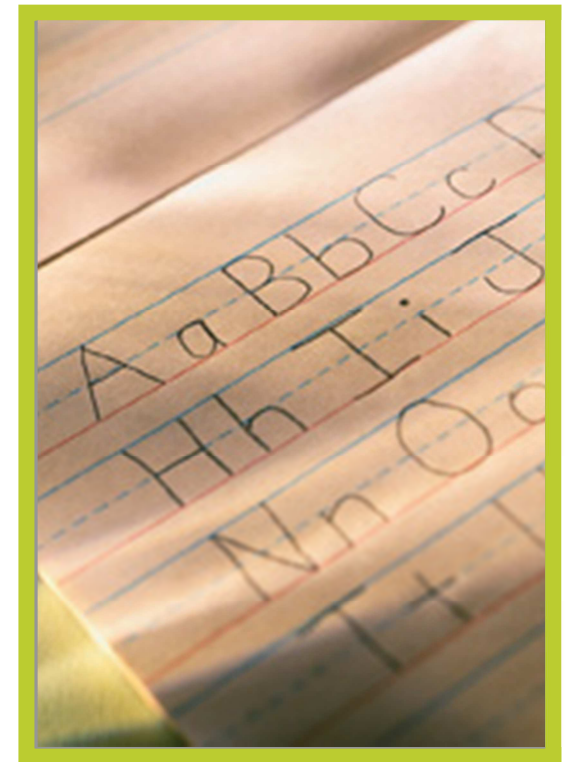
